Serious losses, which frequently occur with quickly perishable fruits like the peach, can doubtless be prevented if adequate means are at hand for disposing of the crop in other ways than by marketing it in the fresh state. The canning of peaches, a comparatively simple and easy process, is one of the most satisfactory methods of handling this fruit on the farm when market conditions for the fresh fruit are unfavorable.
